Gallatin County Market Trends

In May 2025, Gallatin County's real estate market was thriving! The median sales price for single-family homes, condos, and townhouses climbed to \$647,500, marking a stylish 2.8% increase from April. Closed sales soared by an impressive 44.5%, reaching a total of 159. The median price per square foot edged up by 1.4%, now at \$352. New listings made a bold entrance with a 5.4% rise, totaling 311. Homes continued to be elusive, maintaining a consistent 21 days on the market. By the end of the month, inventory expanded by 9.7% to 599 units, and new pending sales inched up by 1.2% to 171. The Greater Big Sky area was excluded from the filter criteria.
